# Proverbs for Parenting: (10) Teaching the Folly of Sinful Anger

## I. What It is

A. Essentially, anger is saying, "I am against that because it is wrong."

B. This anger is folly because in the light of God's mercy and love, sinful anger makes no sense.

## II. How To Teach It

A. We must not respond to anger with anger, but with the soft answer of God's Word (Prov. 15:1).

B. We can teach them about anger by showing the evils of anger.

#### III. Our Only Hope

- A. Jesus Christ shatters the delusion of our anger.
- B. So we must be praying for deliverance from this anger in our lives.
