- II. Why was this necessary? He continues there for our interest.

Ascension Blessings

I. The Faithful Advocate

A. When we sin, we are reminded that He already paid for our sin. We are reminded of this by Jesus' ascension to be our Advocate. 1 John 2:1, 2; Romans 8:34.

B. Christ's prayers as our Advocate is a great blessing because we can then pray to our heavenly Father in the assurance that He hears and answers our prayers (Heb. 4:14-16).

II. The Sure Pledge

- A. Forty days after Christ arose, His human nature was wondrously taken to heaven.
- B. The ascension of Christ is the pledge that all of God's people will be taken to heaven.

III. The Earthly Presence

- A. Although He is in heaven, He is also with us. How can this be?
- B. What a comfort this is to know Christ has not abandoned us, but is present with us. We must live in the awareness of this when disappointment and suffering come.
