Mary was His most devoted and most insightful disciple!

- 4 times (16:21; 17:22-23; 20:18-19; 26:1-2!) He had told them of His coming death and they simply had no idea what He was talking about (Lk 18:34).
- Mary heard Him with her heart. 3 times she appears—always at the feet of Jesus (Lk 10:39; Jn 11:32; 12:3)
- So she wants to encourage Him in His mission and show Him He is not alone, that she appreciates what He is about to do.

Powerful statement of love and faith!

1. What is Jesus worth to you?

What is He worth to God the Father?

Matt 17:5 cf. II Pet 1:16-17

John 17:5, 24

Mary had a glimpse of His true worth, and her response was startling.

How would your life be different if you saw His true worth? Do you think: busier! ? Remember Mary: Luke 10:38-42 Klaus Issler, Wasting Time with God

Grow to understand that the infinitely Worthy One "wasted" Himself on you so you could see His glory and worth!
