What The Cross Meant To Jesus

John 14:28-31

1. The Cross _____ John 14:28

6 who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; 7 rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death – even death on a cross!

9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:6-11

2. The Cross _____ John 14:29

Dogs surround me, a pack of villains encircles me; they pierce my hands and my feet. Psalm 22:16

8 "We are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and the teachers of the law. They will condemn him to death 19 and will turn him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified. On the third day he will be raised to life!"

Matthew 20:18-19

- * There are 1,817 prophecies in the Bible that take up 8,352 of the Bible's verses.
- * There are 31,124 verses in the Bible, the number of prophetic verses amounts to about 27 percent of the total number of verses in the Bible.
- * 1,239 are in the Old Testament, and 578 are in the New Testament.
- * That means that about one-fourth of the Bible is prophecy.
