# 3. How God's gospel brings salvation: God's righteousness is revealed(1:17)

- "the righteousness of God"
  - + as a subjective genitive (a righteousness *about* God)
    - ✓ a divine attribute
    - ✓ a divine activity
  - + as an objective genitive (a righteousness from God)
    - ✓ a divine achievement
