2. The results of God's wrath

- consistent condemnation of homosexuality Lev. 20:13; 1 Cor. 6:9-10; 1 Tim. 9-10
- attempts to justify homosexuality
 - are they 'hardwired' that way, or is it a choice?
 - how has God 'hardwired' us as sexual creatures? Gen. 2:24; Mt. 19:4-6
 - "Sin...puts gravel in our bread [and] wormwood in our cup." - Thomas Watson
- the due penalty of their error...

3. The ramifications of God's wrath

- creatively becoming more and more wicked
- applauding the idolatries and immoralities of others

- 2. Being 'abandoned' by God does not necessarily mean being eternally abandoned. 1 Cor. 6:11; Isa. 19:22; Rev. 2:21
