INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Using the Scriptures, Paul argues that Jesus took God's curse as our sin-bearing Substitute (3:13).
 - a. Christ redeemed us from the law (3:13a).
 - b. The apostle then appealed to Scripture to support this declaration (3:13b).
- 2. PAUL THEN ARGUES THAT JESUS' REDEMPTION FULFILLED GOD'S PROMISE TO ABRAHAM AND HIS BLESSING ON THE GENTILES (3:14).
 - a. The Abrahamic Covenant was not fulfilled until Paul was appointed apostle to the Gentiles (3:14a).
 - b. Receiving the Holy Spirit by faith was the sign of the covenant fulfilled (3:14b).
