BOOK OF ZECHARIAH THE PROBLEM OF DISOBEDIENCE PT 2-CHARACTERISTICS AND CONSEQUENCES OF REBELLION ZECHARIAH 7:7-14

Introduction

Last week we saw four **COMMANDS** or **TESTS OF SPIRITUAL REALITY** that the **LORD** gave the **PEOPLE** in *verses 9 and 10*.

- I. THEY WERE TO EXECUTE TRUE JUDGMENT!
 (Or, EXECUTE JUDGMENT BASED ON THE TRUTH!)
- II. THEY WERE TO SHOW MERCY AND COMPASSION TO THEIR BRETHREN!
- III. THEY WERE NOT TO OPPRESS OTHERS, ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO ARE MORE VULNERABLE!
- IV. THEY WERE NOT TO IMAGINE EVIL AGAINST A BROTHER!
 TRUE MORALITY proceeds from RIGHT MOTIVES of the HEART that show up both in one's THOUGHTS and DEEDS!

The clear inference here is that even though the **CAPTIVITY** had ended and this **REMNANT** of the **PEOPLE** had been restored to the land, there was still a need for many of them to **REPENT**.

They desperately needed to **CHANGE** both their way of **THINKING** and their way of **LIVING**. They needed to begin to practice from the **HEART** the **ETHICAL TEACHING** we saw last week! That would turn their **FASTING** from mere **FORMALISTIC LEGALISM** and **HYPOCRISY** into **SEEKING THE FACE OF GOD**. **EMBRACING TRUTH** in one's **INWARD life** will be **MANIFESTED OUTWARDLY** to those about us.

Next, we see in *Vs. 11-12* the **LORD** points them back to **ISRAEL'S** past!

I. WE SEE THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE REBELLION OF THEIR ANCESTORS.

A variety of expressions are used here to convey this thought of what eventually became an **OBSTINATE REBELLION**.

The three INDICTMENTS of vs 11 together with vs 12 show a

STRONG PROGRESSION OF EVIL!

This shows the **DOWNWARD DESCENT** of their **ANCESTORS** is what eventually led to their **CAPTIVITY**. And it all began with an improper **ATTITUDE** of the **PEOPLE of ISRAEL** regarding the **MINISTRY** and **MESSAGES** of the **LORD'S PROPHETS**

A. We See A First Characteristic Of Their Rebellion!

Vs 11a—"But they refused to hearken..."

We read in SCRIPTURE of how the LORD had repeatedly sent HIS PROPHETS to HIS PEOPLE prior to the BABYLONIAN CAPTIVITY.

Through the **PROPHETS** they were warned to **FORSAKE**THEIR SIN! They were **ENTREATED TO TURN BACK**TO THE LORD! But, there was a continual **REFUSAL** to
HEAR and OBEY the word as vs. 11 states—
"But they refused to hearken..." (i.e. prick up the ears)

i.e. They acted as if they had not been spoken to. When they were bidden by the **LORD's** servants to do something they simply **REFUSED TO OBEY.**

Not only did they persist in their WICKEDNESS and INJUSTICE but they REFUSED the frequent ADMONITIONS and EXHORTATIONS given to them by the LORD!

It was a **DELIBERATE ACT** on their part, not only of not giving attention to the **MESSAGES** that were being presented, but **REFUSING TO ACT** on what was said.

Understand that the WORD OF THE LORD by the mouth

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of HIS PROPHETS was available, but they
DELIBERATELY DECIDED NOT TO PAY
ATTENTION. They REFUSED TO LISTEN to the
LORD'S WORDS, and thereby REFUSED TO MEND
THEIR WAYS AND REPENT!

CONTROL and **AUTHORITY** over their lives!

Jeremiah 5:3—"O LORD, are not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return."

C. We See A Third Characteristic Of Their Rebellion! Vs 11c—"...and stopped their ears, that they should not hear."

Jeremiah 8:5—"Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return." Literally, they made heavy their ears. This refers to a PERSISTENT REFUSAL TO HEED GOD'S WORD so that THE WORD SPOKEN OR PREACHED NO LONGER REACHED THEM!

Jeremiah 11:10—"They are turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers, which refused to hear my words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant which I made with their fathers."

Matthew Henry is quoted as saying, "There are none so deaf as those that will not hear!"

B. We See A Second Characteristic Of Their Rebellion!

Vs 11b—"...and pulled away the shoulder..."

Instead of RECEIVING GOD'S WORD and SERVING

HIM with joyful and glad hearts, they TURNED FROM IT!

They had hearts and minds filled with **prejudices** against the **WORD OF GOD** and **so they resolved in their hearts that nothing said to them would be considered.**

The picture in the language used here is of an animal **refusing** to be bound by the constraint of a yoke and continually **rebelling** against indicated directions.

The phrase "they stopped their ears" implies that this was a **DELIBERATE REFUSAL TO LISTEN TO GOD** and so, they personally bore the responsibility for their unresponsiveness!

The LORD's PEOPLE constantly REFUSED TO GIVE HEED TO HIS WORD being rebellious against its

One of the worst consequences of men TURNING AWAY FROM DOING THE WILL OF GOD is that they have ears, but they don't hear and they have eyes but they do not see and yet GOD will still hold them accountable because of their own stubborn unwillingness to hear and see!

(Look at Isaiah 6:8-13)

D. We See A Fourth Characteristic Of Their Rebellion! Vs 12a—"They made their hearts as an adamant stone."

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This implies that they became so **hard-hearted** that they were **blocking out** whatever the **LORD** was saying to them!

CALAMITIES that overtook that disobedient generation.

Persistent rejection of **GOD'S WORD** eventually produces a **hardened**, **cold and unresponsive state of heart** described here.

A. They Reaped Powerlessness In Prayer. (Vs 13)

Just as the LORD had cried unto them by HIS PROPHETS for so long, so often, and so patiently, yet they would not hear, so they cried unto HIM in their distress for deliverance and HE would not hear.

Notice "they made their hearts," so they were morally responsible for their state. Nothing is so hard or so inflexible as the heart of a presumptuous sinner and they can thank themselves for their condition.

They had been forewarned that if the LORD kept calling to them and they refused to listen, then they would keep calling and He would not hear! That is a just retaliation!

The **PROPHET ZECHARIAH** warned these **JEWS** to learn from the past! The people who **GOD JUDGED** with captivity had **hardened their hearts** and **refused to listen to the WORDS of the LORD!**

Jeremiah 11:11—" Therefore thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon them, which they shall not be able to escape; and though they shall cry unto me, I will not hearken unto them."

The long-term **disobedience** could have only one result. Therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of Hosts." Jeremiah 11:14—"Therefore pray not thou for this people, neither lift up a cry or prayer for them: for I will not hear them in the time that they cry unto me for their trouble."

The people's disobedience to REVEALED TRUTH resulted in DIVINE ANGER. GOD is PATIENT and HE is LONGSUFFERING, but HE WILL NOT BE MOCKED!

Jeremiah 14:12—"When they fast, I will not hear their cry; and when they offer burnt offering and an oblation, I will not accept them: but I will consume them by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence."

2 Chronicles 36:14-20 is a summary of what God did.

Isaiah 1:15—"And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood."

WE SEE THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE REBELLION OF THEIR ANCESTORS.

Proverbs 1:22—"How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? and the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge?"

II. WE SEE THE CONSEQUENCES OF THE REBELLION OF THEIR ANCESTORS! (Vs 13-14)
Here ZECHARIAH tells several of the RESULTANT

Proverbs 1:28—"Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me:"

Verse 13 says "Therefore it is come to pass" i.e. What the **LORD** says He will do, He will do!

They Reaped Powerlessness In Prayer!

- B. They Were Scattered Among The Nations! (Vs 14a)
 Since they demonstrated NO KINDNESS or
 COMPASSION, GOD withdrew HIS KINDNESS and
 COMPASSION. Instead of HEARKENING to their
 PRAYER, HE scattered them with the violence of a
 tornado among other nations.
- C. Their Land Was Laid Desolate! (Vs 14b)

 The conclusion lays the guilt of the whole DESOLATION of the LAND upon their DISOBEDIENT FOREFATHERS.

Since they had **VIOLATED** all the **LAWS** of the **LORD** in their **LAND**, the **LORD** took away all the glories of it.

So we have this picture of **COMPLETE EMPTINESS and UTTER DESOLATION.** Even the roads were void of travelers for it was such a wasteland that no one passed through the land.

And the JEWS were to blame for it all because of their own WICKEDNESS. Their own SIN had TRANSFORMED the PLEASANT LAND, the LAND OF DESIRE AND DELIGHT, the LAND FLOWING WITH MILK AND HONEY, into a DESOLATE, DESERTED and EMPTY LAND.

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The HARDNESS and UNYIELDEDNESS of their HEARTS turned the LAND into a HARD and UNYIELDING PLACE!

Conclusion

So, their TRADITIONS of MOURNINGS and FASTINGS were nothing to the LORD in and of themselves, so long as there was NO REAL SORROW FOR THEIR SIN nor a HEARTFELT DESIRE TO DO HIS WILL as expressed in HIS WORD.

Obeying the **WORD** of the **LORD** was and still is the most important issue that mankind faces!

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
