- 3. Read **Psalm 13**. What are some of the strategies you might devise to more consistently live with the mindset of vv.5-6 when you are feeling the impatience of vv.1-2?
- 4. Read **Romans 12:1-2**. How do you imagine the directives in these verses were a motivation and safeguard for Paul to remain faithful to the message of the gospel when he reasoned with Felix and Drusilla in Acts 24?
- 5. Read **Galatians 6:9-10**. What are some of the reasons you feel like giving up, and how does this passage motivate you that persistence and faithfulness to the truth are always worth it?
