Weekly Bible Verses

“Now it came to pass in the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, that Hezekiah the son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign. . . . And he did that which was right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that David his father did. He removed the high places, and brake the images, and cut down the groves, and brake in pieces the brasen serpent that Moses had made: for unto those days the children of Israel did burn incense to it: and he called it Nehushtan. He trusted in the LORD God of Israel; so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Judah, nor any that were before him.” (2 Kings 18:1,3-5)

Denying Preservation Of Words

Shame on these Fundamental schools who do not believe these verses apply to the original Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek Words. They believe that God has never promised to “*preserve*” His Words.

Never, Never “Pass Away”

Again, as in Matthew 5:17-18, the negative used in this verse is OU ME which is the strongest negative in the Greek language. The Words of the Lord Jesus Christ shall never, never, never “*pass away*.”
