  - D. Time of Writing: The end of Paul's **third** missionary journey, and just before his return to Jerusalem with the offering for the poor believers there. This offering came from the churches in Macedonia and Achaia. 15:26

- III. Introduction 1:1-17
  - A. Greeting Vs 1-7
    - 1. The human author Vs 1-6
      - a. Paul's authority Vs 1-4
        - (1) Servant of Jesus Christ-one who gives themselves completely to the wishes of another person Vs 1a
        - (2) An Apostle-a person who has a face-to-face encounter with Christ (Cf Acts 9:1-6) and has been commissioned by Christ as a spokesperson for Christ Vs 1b
        - (3) Authority made possible by the Gospel of Jesus Christ Vs 2-4
      - b. Paul's commission Vs 5-6
    - 2. The recipients of the letter Vs 7
      - a. Christians living in Rome (Mainly Gentile believers) Vs 7a
      - b. Loved by God Vs 7b
      - c. Called saints by God Vs 7c
      - d. Blessed by God Vs 7d
  - B. The subject of the Letter Vs 8-17
    - 1. Paul's interest in the Believers at Rome Vs 8-13
      - a. He is thankful for them and their testimony as Christians Vs 8
      - b. He is praying for them Vs 9-10
      - c. He **hopes** to visit them (Paul had never been to Rome to visit the Christians) **Vs 11-15**
    - 2. Paul's message for the Believers at Rome Vs 16-17
      - The Gospel, of which Paul is not ashamed Vs 16a
        - 1. Because it is the power of God unto salvation Vs 16b
        - 2. Everyone who **believes** the Gospel experiences the power of God **Vs 16c**
      - b. Through the Gospel, the righteousness of God is presented Vs 17a
        - 1. The righteousness of God received by faith in Christ Vs 17b
        - 2. The righteousness of God was **revealed** in the written word of God (Habakkuk 2:4) **Vs 17c**
