The Gift of the Holy Spirit

I. How He Was Given

- A. The Holy Spirit was given to fulfill the promises of God in the OT.
 - 1. The prophecy of Isaiah 11:2 was fulfilled in Jesus Christ, Who is the Anointed One.
 - 2. The Holy Spirit was poured out on the church in fulfillment of the prophecy of Joel 2:28ff.
- B. May we understand what an amazing gift this is to the church!
 - 1. The first work of Jesus Christ after His exaltation was to send out the Holy Spirit.
 - 2. Acts 2:4 says they were filled with the Holy Spirit. What does this mean?
 - 3. The church has become the temple of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit lives in the church.

- A. He makes us, by a true faith, partaker of Christ and all His benefits.
 - 1. Christ is the life of the church.
 - 2. This relationship is made possible by work of the Holy Spirit.
