The Value of Human Life Genesis 8:20-9:17

Main Point:

Though He destroyed the world by flood, God does care about human life; therefore, value the lives of your fellow man, just as He has valued yours.

- 1. God cares for human life because He promises never to flood the earth again and gives His blessing upon procreation.
- 2. God cares for human life because He makes provision for both the sustenance and protection of it.
- 3. God cares for human life because He sealed all these promises with a covenant.
- 4. God cares for your human life because He gave His Son to die for you.
- 5. Like God, value the lives of your fellow man.
