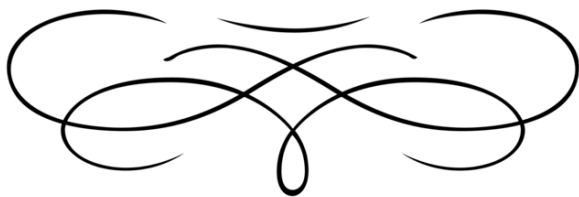

CONFESSING CHRIST
