## **Introduction – Charles Milton Binegar**

**Matthews Account of the Resurrection has 4 Scenes**

- I. At the Tomb (vs. 1-7)**
  - a. It was Sunday morning – no more than 60 hours ago, this whole thing began**
    - i. Surrender**
    - ii. Trial and beating**
    - iii. Scourging**
    - iv. Crucifixion**
      - 1. Began at 9:00 AM**
      - 2. Ended at 3 PM**
      - 3. 7 words**
        - a. Father, forgive them for they do not know what they do**
        - b. Truly I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise**
        - c. Woman, this is your son. & Behold your mother**
        - d. My God, my God, why have you forsaken Me?**
        - e. I thirst**
        - f. It is finished**
        - g. Father into your hand I commend My spirit**
    - v. Claiming of the body**
    - vi. Trip to the tomb**
    - vii. Back home for the Sabbath**
    - viii. Guards posted at the tomb**
    - ix. Earthquake and soldiers quake and stone is rolled away**
    - x. An angel tells the ladies the good news**
- II. En Route to the Disciples (vs. 8-10)**
  - a. Fear and joy for the ladies**
  - b. Jesus met them on the road**
  - c. They worshipped clinging to His feet**
    - i. They were real feet**
    - ii. He accepted worship**
- III. The Big Bribe**
  - a. Jerusalem**
  - b. The guards reported to the religious leaders the events**
  - c. The religious leaders gave them a bribe and talking points**
- IV. Greetings in Galilee**
  - a. Jesus met disciples on a mountainside in Galilee**
  - b. Unsure of time frame**
- V. Take Away**
  - a. What is the ‘what for?’**
  - b. God has a problem with each of us – we are all infected by sin**
  - c. Sin creates a chasm of separation between us and God**
  - d. Our best efforts fall short of spanning the chasm**
  - e. God did for us what we could not do for ourselves – the resurrection was God’s “Amen”**

**Other Relevant Scripture**  
**The Resurrection**  
**April 5, 2015**

**1 Corinthians 15: 3-6 – “Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, 5 and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. 6 Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time”**

**Romans 3:20 – “For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight”**

**Galatians 3: 11 – “no one is justified before God by the law, for “The righteous shall live by faith.”**

**1 Corinthians 15: 17 – “And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins.”**

**1 Corinthians 15: 20 – “ But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.”**

**John 3: 16 – “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.”**

**Ephesians 2: 8,9 - “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.”**

**Titus 3: 5 – “he saved us, not because of works [good deeds] done by us in righteousness”**
