- ¹ Bless, O my soul, Yahweh,
and all that is within me, His holy name.¹
- ² Bless, O my soul, Yahweh,
and do not forget all His benefits:
- ³ The One pardoning all your iniquity,
the One healing all your diseases.
- ⁴ The One redeeming from the Pit² your life,
the One crowning you with lovingkindness and
compassion.
- ⁵ The One satisfying your ornamentation with good;
your youth renews itself like an eagle.
- ⁶ Doing acts of righteousness is Yahweh,
and acts of judgment for all the oppressed.
- ⁷ He kept making known His ways to Moses,
to the sons of Israel His deeds.
- ⁸ Compassionate and gracious is Yahweh,
long to anger and abounding in lovingkindness.
- ⁹ Not to perpetuity will He contend,
and not to eternity will He harbor *anger*.
- ¹⁰ Not according to our sins has He done for us,
and not according to our iniquities has he heaped benefits
on us.

- ¹¹ For as the height of the heavens over the earth,
so has prevailed His lovingkindness over³ His fearers.
- ¹² As the distance of the east from the west,
so He distances from us our iniquities.
- ¹³ As shows compassion a father upon his sons,
so shows compassion Yahweh upon His fearers.
- ¹⁴ For He Himself knows how we are formed,⁴
mindful⁵ that dust are we.
- ¹⁵ *Frail* man — as the grass are his days,
as a flower of the field, thus he flowers.
- ¹⁶ For the wind passes over it and —no more!
and its place no longer recognizes it.
- ¹⁷ But the lovingkindness of Yahweh *is* from eternity even unto
eternity upon His fearers,
and His righteousness for the sons' sons.
- ¹⁸ For those who keep His covenant,
and for those who remember His precepts, to do them.
- ¹⁹ Yahweh in the heavens has established His throne,
and His kingdom over all rules.
- ²⁰ Bless Yahweh, His angels, mighty of strength, those doing His
word,
listening to the voice of His word.
- ²¹ Bless Yahweh, all His armies,
attending to Him, doing His pleasure.
- ²² Bless Yahweh, all His works in all places of His rule.
