Our Lord's Death

AW Pink

I. Natural - i.e. a 'real' death, actual / 'normal'

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,
* **Phil 2:5-8**

II. Un-Natural - i.e. 'ab-normal'

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin *is* death; {He had **no sin!**}
* **2 Cor 5:21** he knew no sin - practically, spiritually, intimately
* **1 Pet 1:19, 2:22** he did no sin - physically, nor verbally
* **1 John 3:5** he had no sin - in-wardy; soul-clean

even Pilate said (5x) '*I find no fault in this man*' (Lk 23: 4, 14; John 18:38, 19: 4, 6)
Therefore : Death had no claim on him (Acts 2:24)

III. Preter-Natural - i.e. marked out & determined for *him* beforehand

* **Acts 2:22-23**
Rev 13:8 the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
* **Isa 53:7-8**

IV. Super-Natural - i.e. different from every other death (~ birth / life)

1. spiritually

note - John 19:31-33 [the two were alive]
* **Eccl 8:6-8** John 19:30
Lk 23:46 Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit:
John 10:17-18

2. physically - his blood was Divine

* **Acts 20:28**
* **2 Cor 5:19** [close with vv 18-21]

the third day 12x in gospels Mt 16:21 17:23 20:19 27:64
Mk 9:31 10:34
Lk 9:22 13:32 18:33 24:7, 21, 46
Acts 10:40 1 Cor 15:4

total = 14 regarding His resurrection (14 is the number of Salvation & Deliverance)

after three days Mark 8:31 Mt 27:63
