- **What?**
  - What is it about? It is about Being Right with God through the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.
  - What is it? It is a letter written by Paul to Roman believers.
- **When?**
  - When is it written? It is written about 67 AD, as Paul finished his third missionary journey.
- **Who?**
  - Who wrote it? Paul wrote it as an Apostle by Office, identifying as a bond servant of Jesus who is set apart for the Gospel
- **Why?**
  - Why is it so important? It is the Grace groups from God the Holy Spirit to a church that Paul had not yet visited.
  - Why does Paul write Romans? Paul is wanting to make sure they are on the same page with the Gospel as he endeavors to head to them on his way to Spain.

## **1. The Gospel is Concerning Jesus, The Son of God.**

<sup>3</sup>concerning his Son,  
who was descended from David  
according to the flesh

- **What does Son of God mean?**

*As God's Son, Jesus is God.*

- **When did Jesus become the Son?**

*He has always been the Son (Psalm 2:7-12)*

## **2. The Gospel is Concerning Jesus, The Son of David.**

- **Who is David?**
  - **Israel's Shepherd Boy**
  - **Israel's Greatest King**
  - **Israel's Valiant Warrior**
  - **Israel's Worship Leader**

- **Israel's Failed Father**
  
- **Who is David's Son?**
  - **One with An Eternal Kingship (2 Samuel 7:12-17; Psalm 89:3-4)**
  - **One with A Just Rule (Isaiah 11:1-5; Jeremiah 23:5-6).**
  - **One with An International Rule (Isaiah 11:10).**
  - **One with A Rule of Peace and Prosperity (Jeremiah 33:14-17; Psalm 118).**
  - **One Who is able to also be an everlasting High Priest (Psalm 110).**

### **3. The Gospel is Concerning Jesus, the Son of God and Son of David.**
