## The Roman Trial Matthew 27:11-31 April 5, 2015

## Main Point:

Jesus, the innocent King of the Jews, took your place on the cross so that you could have life by His death; therefore, live for Him who died for you!

1. Jesus is the King of the Jews.

2. As the King of the Jews, Jesus had done no wrong.

- 3. Despite His innocence, Jesus was condemned in the place of a guilty criminal.
- 4. He endured this great injustice for you.

5. Live for the King who died for you!

**Luke 23:2** <sup>2</sup> And they began to accuse Him, saying, "We found this *fellow* perverting the nation, and forbidding to pay taxes to Caesar, saying that He Himself is Christ, a King." (NKJV)

**Luke 23:5** <sup>5</sup> But they were the more fierce, saying, "He stirs up the people, teaching throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee to this place." (NKJV)

**Isaiah 53:7** <sup>7</sup> He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth. (NKJV)

**Luke 23:4, 13-15** <sup>4</sup> So Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowd, "I find no fault in this Man." ... <sup>13</sup> Then Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests, the rulers, and the people, <sup>14</sup> said to them, "You have brought this Man to me, as one who misleads the people. And indeed, having examined *Him* in your presence, I have found no fault in this Man concerning those things of which you accuse Him; <sup>15</sup> "no, neither did Herod, for I sent you back to him; and indeed nothing deserving of death has been done by Him. (NKJV)

**Luke 23:15-16**  $^{15}$  ... "indeed nothing deserving of death has been done by Him.  $^{16}$  "I will therefore chastise Him and release Him" (NKJV)

1 Peter 2:22 <sup>22</sup> "[Jesus] committed no sin ... (NKJV)

**Hebrews 4:15** <sup>15</sup> For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are, yet* without sin. (NKJV)

**Romans 5:6-9** <sup>6</sup> For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. <sup>7</sup> For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. <sup>8</sup> But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. <sup>9</sup> Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. (NKJV)

**2 Corinthians 5:14-15** <sup>14</sup> For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; <sup>15</sup> and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again. (NKJV)
