4. What is the result of God’s wrath “turned away?”
5. Who will give thanks?
6. “God [Himself] is my salvation.” Do we ever act as if something else is our salvation?
7. What are the positive and negative actions of faith according to verse 2?
8. LORD GOD is literally “Yah Yahweh.” Yah is the diminutive form of Yahweh and may express endearment. Why did Isaiah give this name for God here?
9. Read Exodus 15:2. Describe the context of Moses singing this and relate it to “my strength and my song.”
10. How is God YOUR strength and song?
