

## WHY SHE ISN'T MARRIED (PROPAGANDA!)

TEXT: 1 Timothy 5:14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

15 For some are already turned aside after Satan.

Isaiah 4:1 And in that day seven women shall take hold of one man, saying, We will eat our own bread, and wear our own apparel: only let us be called by thy name, to take away our reproach.

1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; 2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; 3 Forbidding to marry...

1 Corinthians 7:2 Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.

7 For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.

1 Timothy 5:9 Let not a widow be taken into the number under threescore years old...

1 Timothy 2:14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression. 15 Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

"I'm almost 50 and full of regret it's too late to have children...I work hard, own a home...In previous relationships I've had two abortions and two miscarriages and I'm not sure I ever recovered...I suppose I am a typical spinster cat-woman..." (The Guardian, Jan. 26, 2020)

"She Wrote Fake News for Cosmopolitan and Now Regrets Misleading Women on Feminism...Browder, a Cosmopolitan magazine writer for 20 years, describes what she wrote as 'propaganda'...The goal? To sell women on the idea that sexual liberation is the path to the single woman's personal fulfillment..."

"...Browder still owns her original copy of the rules today. Flipping through the pages, she reads two examples out loud: 'Unless you are a recognized authority on the subject, profound statements must be attributed to somebody appropriate, even if the writer has to invent the authority...'...'Try to locate some of the buildings, restaurants, nightclubs...as well as entire case histories...in cities other than New York, even if you deliberately have to plant them elsewhere'..."

"By planting salacious stories about women having extravagant affairs in places such as Cleveland and Des Moines, Browder says, 'the magazine spread its mores throughout the country and throughout the culture by pretending that they were much more widespread than they actually were...'..."

""...what I would like...for young women today, [is] to tell them the truth so they could see how my generation got it wrong, why we got it wrong...a young woman, an insecure young woman, reads these magazines and thinks that she has to have perfume, cosmetics, hair products, beautiful clothes, singles travel...abortions, contraception, when she thinks she has to have all of these things, she's going to spend a lot of money...'"

"'They're telling you on the one hand, 'Be yourself;' on the other hand, they're saying, 'You're not good enough the way you are, buy all this stuff to be beautiful.' Why aren't you beautiful just the way you are?.....And 'your hair color is wrong...'...."

"...Browder pauses, looking at the iPhone on her kitchen table, 'how liberated are we if our girls have got that in their pockets before they can even think?"" (Daily Signal, 2020)

"...Erin Pizzey ought to be a feminist hero. In 1971, she founded the first women's refuge [shelter]...The first of her many books on domestic violence, Scream Quietly or the Neighbours Will Hear, led to a TV documentary. She attracted fans such as Boy George..."

"'She single-handedly did as much for the cause of women as any other woman alive,' Deborah Ross wrote in The Independent...By 2009, the break was complete. Pizzey wrote for the *Daily* Mail that she had realized feminism was 'a lie'...Pizzey is now an advocate for the men'srights movement, serving as editor at large of the anti-feminist website A Voice for Men..." "...like lords or sailors of yore, a young woman is encouraged to embark upon the world, seek her fortune and sow her oats, and only much later closer to 30 than 20 - consider the possibility of settling down. Even religious conservatives, who disapprove of [fornication], accept the nowcommon wisdom that it is better to put off marriage than do it too early..."

"...the more educated and ambitious a woman is the more likely she is to delay marriage and children, the Census Bureau reports. "...she...couldn't convince them that she really had met the man she wanted to marry, that she didn't want to keep going out to bars in the evenings and clubs on the weekends, postponing her marriage for half a decade until she reached an age that her friends would consider more suitable..."

"I remember having, in my early 20s, long and passionate conversations with my female friends about our need to be strong, to stand alone...never compromise our souls by succumbing to [domestic life]. And yet at the same time, we constantly felt the need to shore each other up."

"...despite our confidence in ourselves as independent women, we somehow feared that even a gentle gust of wind blowing from the opposite direction would send us spiraling back into the 1950s..."
