Romans 6:1-2, 14 (942)

Romans 6 – 8 are marvelous meditations upon the biblical gospel, which always flows from love. Romans 6 answers the first and most logical objection one can bring to the gospel: that it leads to lawless conduct. We saw that to 'fall from grace' is to into legalism. But does that mean that grace leads to license – an utter disregard for God's law? Today we see how righteous living actually comes about, and not surprisingly that answer is 'by grace' (v 1, 14)
