TEXT: Mark 16:9 Now when **Jesus was risen** early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

10 And she went and told them that had been with him, as they mourned and wept.

**John 2:19 Jesus answered and said
unto them, Destroy this temple, and
in three days I will raise it up.**

**21 But he spake of the temple of his
body.**

5 They that were full have hired out themselves for bread; and they that were hungry ceased: so that the barren hath born seven...

**6 The LORD killeth, and maketh
alive: he bringeth down to the
grave, and bringeth up.**

**7 The LORD maketh poor, and
maketh rich: he bringeth low, and
lifteth up.**

**Job 36:27 For he maketh
small the drops of water: they
pour down rain according to
the vapour thereof:**

Psalms 107:28 Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses.

29 He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still.

**Proverbs 10:22 The
blessing of the LORD, it
maketh rich, and he
addeth no sorrow with it.**

**Ecclesiastes 3:11...no man
can find out the work that
God maketh from the
beginning to the end.**

Hebrews 6:17 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise **the immutability of his counsel**, confirmed it by an oath:
18 That by two immutable things, in which **it was impossible for God to lie**, we might have a strong consolation...

Romans 1:23 And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

**Luke 1:36 And, behold, thy cousin
Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son
in her old age: and this is the sixth
month with her, who was called barren.**

**37 For with God nothing shall be
impossible.**

Matthew 19:26 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but **with God all things are possible.**
