- B. Make sure your submission is sincere from the heart. vv. 5b-6 (Rom. 12:11, Tit. 2:9-10, 1 Cor. 6:20, Matt. 20:28)
- C. Ultimately, your service is to the Lord who will recompense each one. vv. 7-8 (Eccl. 9:10, Col. 3:23-24)

IV. Masters also must submit to the Lord in heaven. v. 9

- A. Masters are to treat their slaves with fairness. (Deut. 24:14-15, Jas. 2:13)
- B. Your motivation is that you will give an account to your Master in heaven. (Ps. 140:12, Phil. 2:10-11)
