- II. Contrasting -"this world, that world" (verses 34-36)

The Bible continually separates: 2 different Worlds – segment of time

- A. Temporal "this world" living in physical bodies on earth
- **B.** Eternal "that world"
- counted worthy not worthy(Jesus)
 - obtain something must be bought
 - comes by resurrection
 - no exclusive partnership
 - no need for procreation

- no death
- = to angels
 - o we were made lower
 - o we will get promoted to equal
 - o we will get promoted to rule
- Children of God-born into family
- Child of resurrection birthed Immortality comes after death and

resurrection – not as a continuation of this present life as Greek mythology held.

III. Contextual - "at the bush"

(verses 37-40)

The Bible is powerful because It is:

- A. Clear
- **B** Consistent
- C. Correct

Sadducees believed:

- > Uniformitarianism
- > No supernatural events
- > No Miracles
- > No Angels
- > Non-traditionalism
- Only the Torah, Pentateuch, Moses dependable
- ➤ No resurrection or Immortality of the soul
- > Free Will with no Predestination
- ➤ No punishment or rewards of the immortal soul
- > Freedom from Ritual and Legalism

Issues of that Day:

- ➤ Uniformitarianism everything stays the same and no real change, history is cyclical
- > If Man dies --- That's it, nothing else
- Greek Mythology idea of Immortality no death, just keep on living

Like the Angels

- > Indirect comparison not direct or same
- > Closest to "neither can they die"-immortality
- > State of fixed holiness
- No procreation or family ties outside of God's family
- > Given supernatural powers
- > Enjoy God's Presence
