⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: ¹⁰ But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

¹² Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

¹³ Thou shalt not kill.

¹⁵ Thou shalt not steal.

QUESTION # 93: WHAT IS THE MORAL LAW?

ANSWER:

THE MORAL LAW IS THE DECLARATION OF THE WILL OF GOD TO MANKIND, DIRECTING AND BINDING EVERYONE TO PERSONAL, PERFECT, AND PERPETUAL CONFORMITY AND OBEDIENCE THEREUNTO, IN THE FRAME AND DISPOSITION OF THE WHOLE MAN, SOUL AND BODY,^A AND IN PERFORMANCE OF ALL THOSE DUTIES OF HOLINESS AND RIGHTEOUSNESS WHICH HE OWETH TO GOD AND MAN:^B PROMISING LIFE UPON THE FULFILLING, AND THREATENING DEATH UPON THE BREACH OF IT.^C
