Gabriel comes to Daniel to encourage him, give him further revelation, and to help him understand (vs.20-23).

-Daniel's reading of the Word led him to pray, which resulted in him receiving further understanding.

- Even after seventy years, Daniel's thinking was still regulated by the life and worship of Jerusalem.

The Revelation of Messiah's Coming:

-Three Major Views: 1) Events Occurring During the Time of Antiochus

- 2) First Coming/Events at the End
- 3) First Coming/Destruction of Jerusalem

-Structure: v. 24 covers the entire period of the seventy weeks

- v. 25: divides the first sixty-nine weeks into two periods (seven weeks / sixty-two weeks)
- v. 26: describes what takes place after the sixty-nine weeks
- v. 27: describes the final week in more detail
- v. 24: transgression finished; sin brought to an end; atonement made; righteousness established; vision and prophecy sealed up; the Most Holy anointed.
- v. 25: 7 weeks-Jerusalem rebuilt / 62 weeks-Messiah
- v. 26: Messiah crucified / Jerusalem destroyed
- v. 27: Messiah crucified / Jerusalem destroyed

## Practical Lessons:

- 1) God's people are precious to Him.
- 2) Christ's sacrifice has put an end to all sacrifice.
