

## The Five Solas of Romans

### Romans 1:1-7

- 1) **Sola gratia** (v. 1a): Salvation is by God's *grace alone*
  - a) Blasphemers transferred from darkness to light
  - b) Slaves of sin become slaves of Christ
  - c) Worshipers of self become apostles of Christ
- 2) **Sola fide** (v. 5): Salvation is through *faith alone*
  - a) Faith concerns believing-receiving-trusting
  - b) True faith produces obedience
- 3) **Solus Christus** (v. 1-5): the object of faith is *Christ alone*
  - a) Jesus is the gospel of God
  - b) Yeshua (Jesus) is the continuation of OT teachings
- 4) **Sola Scriptura** (v. 2): God's word is found in *Scripture alone*
- 5) **Sola Dei gloria** (v. 5): Everything to the *glory of God alone*
  - a) He saves sinners for His sake
  - b) He sends us for His purposes
  - c) He fulfills Scripture for His truth
  - d) He saves us for obedience for His name's sake
