Ps 18:1-3, 31, 46-48

¹I love you, O LORD, my strength.

² The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

³ I call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies.

³¹ For who is God, but the LORD?
And who is a rock, except our God?—

⁴⁶ The LORD lives, and blessed be my rock, and exalted be the God of my salvation—

⁴⁷ the God who gave me vengeance and subdued peoples under me,

⁴⁸ who rescued me from my enemies; yes, you exalted me above those who rose against me; you delivered me from the man of violence.

- ⁶ The nations rage, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts.
 ⁷ The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress.

Ps 59:1-4, 9, 10, 16, 17

¹Deliver me from my enemies, O my God; protect me from those who rise up against me; ² deliver me from those who work evil, and save me from bloodthirsty men. ³ For behold, they lie in wait for my life; fierce men stir up strife against me. For no transgression or sin of mine, O LORD, ⁴ for no fault of mine, they run and make ready. Awake, come to meet me, and see!

O my Strength, I will watch for you, for you, O God, are my fortress.
 My God in his steadfast love will meet me; God will let me look in triumph on my enemies.

¹⁶ But I will sing of your strength; I will sing aloud of your steadfast love in the morning.

For you have been to me a fortress and a refuge in the day of my distress.

- ⁷ On God rests my salvation and my glory; my mighty rock, my refuge is God.
- ⁸ Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us.

 twice have I heard this:
 that power belongs to God,
 and that to you, O Lord, belongs steadfast love.
 For you will render to a man according to his work.

- **A. Creation** Psalm 19:1-6
- B. Providence

Psalm 65:6-7, 9-13

- ⁶ the one who by his strength established the mountains, being girded with might;
- ⁷ who stills the roaring of the seas, the roaring of their waves, the tumult of the peoples,
- ⁹ You visit the earth and water it; you greatly enrich it; the river of God is full of water; you provide their grain, for so you have prepared it.
 ¹⁰ You water its furrows abundant!
- 10 You water its furrows abundantly, settling its ridges,

softening it with showers, and blessing its growth.

- ¹¹ You crown the year with your bounty; your wagon tracks overflow with abundance.
- 12 The pastures of the wilderness overflow, the hills gird themselves with joy,
- 13 the meadows clothe themselves with flocks, the valleys deck themselves with grain, they shout and sing together for joy.

- ¹⁹ He made the moon to mark the seasons; the sun knows its time for setting.
- ²⁰ You make darkness, and it is night, when all the beasts of the forest creep about.

- ¹⁰ You make springs gush forth in the valleys; they flow between the hills;
- 11 they give drink to every beast of the field; the wild donkeys quench their thirst.
- ¹² Beside them the birds of the heavens dwell; they sing among the branches.
- ¹³ From your lofty abode you water the mountains; the earth is satisfied with the fruit of your work.
