I. David's Words And His Groaning – vs. 1

'ē·mēr – words; a brief statement

hā·gîg - sighing, a groaning sound; meditation (out loud muttering that may accompany the thought, but not speaking to any particular human)

II. A Cry For Help From His King And His God – vs. 2

šē·wǎ' - pleading, imploring, the act. of requesting or asking for help as an urgent, intense request

bō·qēr – morning; morning light

śā·nē - hate, abhor, detest, loathe, be hostile; be an enemy
(be in open hostility and strife with another)

tā·'āb - detest, abhor, loathe, despise, degrade

hā·lāl - be arrogant, boast (be in a state of improper
pride and haughtiness)

pā·'āl 'ā·wēn – doers/makers of evil/sin

'ā·bād - destroy, annihilate, terminate.

V. Hope In Right Relationship To God – vs. 7

bā·yit - dwelling place, house, temple

rōb - large amount, abundance, plentiful

hē·sēd - loving-kindness, goodness, mercy

hā·wā - bow down, prostrate oneself

VI. God's Deliverance From Evildoers – vs. 8-10

nāḥâ – lead, guide

VII. God's Protection – vs. 11-12

ḥā·sāh - take refuge in (go to a place where one will find safety, rest, or comfort, implying the place of refuge is a place to be trusted to keep one safe)

bā·rāk - bless another, commend (speak words invoking divine favor, with the intent that the object will have favorable circumstances or state at a future time)

ṣād·dîq – just; innocent; righteous; vindicated

ṣin·nāh - shield, large shield, buckler
