Responding to God's Word Ezekiel 33:21-33

Main Point:

Since God always fulfills His Word, never ignore it but hear and obey it.

1. God's Word is always fulfilled.

2. God's Word should never be ignored.

3. God's Word must be heard and obeyed.

Ezekiel 24:25-26 25 "And you, son of man—will it not be in the day when I take from them their stronghold, their joy and their glory, the desire of their eyes, and that on which they set their minds, their sons and their daughters: 26 on that day one who escapes will come to you to let you hear it with your ears; (NKJV)

(NKJV)
