### PRAYER COVER

Ephesians 6:18-24

#### I. THE CALL TO PRAYER

- **A. <u>At All Times</u>** (Ps 62:8)
  - 1. Every Opportunity
    - **a. Scheduled** ()—corporate assembly, personal devotions
    - **b. Called**—corporate in response to a crisis
    - **c. Spontaneous**—whenever need or opportunity presents
    - d. Any Time (Lk 6:12)—day or night
  - 2. Any Location (Ps 61:1-2139:7-10)—God is everywhere accessible
  - 3. <u>Continual Conversation</u> (1 Thes 5:17)—ongoing internal dialogue
- **B.** In the Spirit (Rom 8:26; Gal 5:26; Jude 1:20)—
  - 1. Internally in an on-going spirit of prayer
  - 2. Sensitive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit
  - 3. Relying on the Holy Spirit to help us as we pray

# C. All Kinds of Prayers

- 1. Secret & Solitary (Mat 6:6)—alone with God, prayer closet
- **2. Public & United** (Joel 2:17Mat 18:19-20; Act 1:14)
- 3. Formal or Informal
- **4. Spoken or Unspoken** (Gen 24:12-15; Neh 2:4-5; Ps 139:4)—
- **5. Prepared or Spontaneous**—written, read, memorized
- 6. For Self & for Others—personal needs and intercession
- 7. For Any Reason ()—needs, thanks, praise, confession
- **D.** All Kinds of Requests ()—not a good work but a relationship

- E. For All the Saints (Gal 6:2)—Intercession for all Christians
  - 1. Every Christian needs prayer.
  - 2. <u>The Church</u> is bigger than <u>this</u> church.—congregation, denomination
  - **3.** <u>Ministers</u> need special prayer. (Rom 15:30; 2 Cor 1:11; Php 1:19; Col 4:3; 2 Thes 3:1-2)

#### II. THE CHARGE TO SOLDIERS

- A. Keep Alert—be aware
  - **1. The <u>devil</u> and his schemes** (Mk 14:37-38; Lk 21:36; 1 Cor 16:13; 2 Cor 2:11; 1 Pet 5:8)
  - **2. The condition of our battle buddies**—(Jas 5:16; 1 Jn 5:16; )
  - 3. The prompting of the Holy Spirit to pray for someone
- B. With All Perseverance (Mat 7:7; Lk 18:1; Mk 9:28-29; )—takes time
  - 1. Because none of us will ever not need prayer in this life.
  - 2. Because God answers prayer. Don't give up!

## III. THE INTER-CONNECTION OF THE CHURCH (21-24)

- **A. To God** (Isa 64:4; Jn 14:14; 16:26-27)—direct line of communication
  - 1. God is real and present.
  - 2. Prayer connects us to our power source.
  - 3. Prayer accesses on Earth the resources of Heaven.
- B. <u>To One Another</u> ()—assist one another with our prayers
  - 1. We fight for and with one another—not against each other!
  - 2. We fight against the devil.
