- What are the differences and similarities of belief, confession and calling? (9-13)
- What are the differences and similarities of righteousness and salvation? (9-13)
- What do you notice about the scope of those who will be saved by faith?
- What makes Joel 2 a particularly meaningful passage for Paul to cite in 10:13?
- **Community Group Focus Questions: What human actions does Paul say lead to salvation and what divine actions are behind those? How does knowing these things help you as a witness of Jesus Christ in the world?**
