- What is the difference between the demon's belief and the belief we are called to embrace? (v. 19)
- What is remarkable to you about the faith of Abraham and Rahab? (vv. 20-26)
- How is the example of Rahab helpful? (v. 25)
- Who is someone you know who shows their faith in action? How do they do this?
- What is encouraging about their faith?
