## Main Point:

As His disciple, Jesus uses you to call the lost out of darkness; therefore, confidently, whole-heartedly, and joyfully share the gospel of the kingdom with all people.

1. All humanity, by nature, sits in darkness.

2. Jesus came to deliver the lost out of darkness.

3. Jesus continues to call the lost out of darkness through the ministry of His disciples.

4. Confidently, whole-heartedly, and joyfully share the gospel of the kingdom with all people.
