- 1. Punishment in the "world" to come
- 2. Suffer in "body"
- 3. Created place Matt 25:41

Comfortable Presence

- 1. God is omnipresent, to include hell Prov 15:3
- 2. God is currently "longsuffering" 2 Pet 3:9
- 3. Hell is only God's justice and wrath

Grievous Torments

- 1. God is just in his dealing with sin
- 2. Body Matt 10:28
 - a. Gehenna
 - b. Mk 9:47-48
 - c. Matt 25:30
- 3. Soul
 - a. No worship
 - b. Phil 2:10-11, Ps 2:9
- 4. Degrees of Punishment Matt 11:20-24
 - a. WLC Q150, 151
 - b. Sin
 - c. Person

Forever

- 1. Heb 9:27
- 2. Postmortem evangelism Jn 10:16, Jn 5:25
 - a. Doesn't account for those who have already heard the gospel
 - b. Contradicts scripture Lk 16:19-31

False Doctrines

- 1. Annihilationism those in hell will be completely destroyed
 - a. Rev 20:10, 14-15
- 2. Universalism everyone will eventually be saved by Christ
- 3. Purgatory a place where the elect undergo one final act of purification for their sins before entering heaven
 - a. Heb 7:26-27, Lk 23:42-43
