2023.05.13 Family Worship lesson in "the Proverb of the day" Proverbs 13:11
"An Elevating Approach to Wealth"

Wealth gained by dishonesty will be diminished, But he who gathers by labor will increase.

Pastor teaches his family a selection from "the Proverb of the day." In this verse of Holy Scripture, the Holy Spirit teaches us that those who gain wealth in any other way than grace-driven righteousness will lose everything in the end.

Proverbs 13 verse 11. These are God's words. Wealth gained by dishonesty will be diminished. But he who gathers by labor. Will increase.

And that anything other than the ways by which he has given us, which is primarily labor and productivity. Although of course generosity and charity. Inheritance from parents, which is A special sort of. Uh, generosity. Uh, Putting wealth to work. By investing in that which is productive. Uh, these are These are some ways.

That the lord has given us in his word that are appropriate ways. Of increasing wealth but there are all the ways. That. Um, That we are tempted to try to get it instead. Like cheating others, or straight up stealing from them. Or taking shortcuts. Doing that, which is not particularly productive.

And, And many other such things. Now. Because obedience comes from a heart that is joined to the lord jesus christ. Wealth, that is gained. Um, by labor, for instance. Will increase. Well, that has gained honestly by labor. The parallel is the first part wealth gained, by dishonesty will be diminished.

It actually doesn't matter how much you have, if you don't have Christ, Because you will not take it into the next life and even what you have had and what you have done will testify against you. Like, The rich man was told when jesus told us about the rich man and lazarus, You had your good things.

Already. So, do not Uh, do not be tempted. To gain things in a dishonest manner. The only thing that is worth having is god and his favor, whatever you have within his providence. There are many believers who do prosper and he blesses them. Abraham david so forth. Whatever you have, in addition to him, Um, there's good and useful.

You enjoy him and his goodness in it. You glorify an honor him and how you use it. Uh, but Don't be tempted to view. Uh, wealth property money. As worth accumulating for its own sake. Because that's when you're tempted to. Be dishonest about how you get it to take advantage.

Of others and try to manipulate the providence of god. Which of course comes from covetousness. Violates the 10th commandment, which violates the whole first table of the law. And the first great commandment. It really is a root of all kinds of evil. To love wealth for its own sake.

And whenever you're tempted to get something dishonestly. You can be sure that that root Of all kinds of evils behind. That temptation. So learn to recognize it especially if you're mulling over and your mind how much you would like a particular thing and start coming up with ways that you can get it.

Um, Check yourself at that point. You're treating wealth in an incorrect way. You're putting yourself in danger of getting it dishonestly. And, You should remember that. It is those who have christs to whom everything belongs, You don't actually have to manipulate anything. You just honor him by working hard with your hands.

So that you may not only eat for yourself, what may have something to give, To your brother when he has need. Amen, let's pray. Our father in heaven. We thank you. That christ is For us, the perfect display of your wisdom. In human form. We praise you that you are infinite eternal.

And unchangeable, in your wisdom from everlasting to everlasting. And that it is the sun, especially in whom you communicate that wisdom. And whom you have communicated that wisdom to us, And now, in his incarnation. And whom you have even modeled for us. Well, what it looks like when a man thinks properly of wealth, So we pray for the help of your spirit who makes us to delight in you.

And to lighten your son. And to be content in all circumstances, That we would be. A full and abounding. With your love and with joy and with peace. And with all the other fruit, That your spirit produces. So that we would not be tempted. To try to get wealth dishonestly.

And that we would be diligent with self-control. That laboring desiring to honor you An image you and do good to others. Granted, we ask in jesus name, Amen.
