- 28:6 Better is a poor man who walks in his integrity than a rich man who is crooked in his ways
- 13:23 The fallow ground of the poor would yield much food, but it is swept away through injustice
- 28:8 Whoever multiplies his wealth by interest and profit gathers it for him who is generous to the poor
- 22:2 The rich and the poor meet together; the LORD is the maker of them all

- 21:13 Whoever closes his ear to the cry of the poor will himself call out and not be answered
- 14:21 blessed is he who is generous to the poor
- 19:17 Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the LORD, and he will repay him for his deed
