#### HEBREWS: The absolute greatness of Jesus as Son—Part 1

(So that God's people will not become complacent and compromise, but persevere)

Sermon: Hebrews 1:1-3

Jesus is greater than the prophets and thus the complete and final Word of God.

We see:

- 1. In the *past* God spoke *in the prophets* (v.1)
- 2. Now God speaks in a Son (v.2a).
- 3. The greatness of this *Son* (vv. 2b,3).

# <u>The Westminster Confession of Faith</u> Chapter 1—Of the Holy Scriptures

WCF 1.1 Although the light of nature, and the works of creation and providence do so far manifest the goodness, wisdom, and power of God, as to leave men inexcusable;(1) yet are they not sufficient to give that knowledge of God, and of His will, which is necessary unto salvation:(2) therefore it pleased the Lord, at sundry times, and in divers manners, to reveal Himself, and to declare that His will unto His Church;(3) and afterwards, for the better preserving and propagating of the truth, and for the more sure establishment and comfort of the Church against the corruption of the flesh, and the malice of Satan and of the world, to commit the same wholly unto writing;(4) which maketh the Holy Scripture to be most necessary;(5) those former ways of God's revealing His will unto His people being now ceased.(6)

# <u>The Belgic Confession</u> Article 10 – Jesus Christ True and Eternal God

We believe that Jesus Christ according to His divine nature is the onlybegotten Son of God,1 begotten from eternity, not made, nor created for then He would be a creature - but of the same essence with the Father, equally-eternal, who reflects the glory of God and bears the very stamp of His nature (Heb 1:3), and is equal to Him in all things.2 He is the Son of God, not only from the time that He assumed our nature but from all eternity,3 as these testimonies, when compared with each other, teach us: Moses says that God created the world;4 the apostle John says that all things were made by the Word which he calls God.5 The letter to the Hebrews says that God made the world through His Son;6 likewise the apostle Paul says that God created all things through Jesus Christ.7 Therefore it must necessarily follow that He who is called God, the Word, the Son, and Jesus Christ, did exist at that time when all things were created by Him. Therefore He could say, Truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am (John 8:58), and He prayed, Glorify Thou Me in Thy own presence with the glory which I had with Thee before the world was made (John 17:5). And so He is true, eternal God, the Almighty, whom we invoke, worship, and serve.


