- "Know for certain..."
  - Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see." (Heb 11:1)
- Waiting patiently... for 430 years!
  - "all these... did not received what was promised... since God had provided something better for us..."
- We too can 'know for certain...'

### The sign of the covenant

- Hear the promises of God
- Circumcision a sign, not a condition
  - o a 'setting apart' FROM the nations... FOR the nations

#### What really matters now?

- neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation (Galatians 6:15)
  - o ...but only faith working through love (Galatians 5:6)

That is why it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on grace and be guaranteed to all his offspring—not only to the adherent of the law but also to the one who shares the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all... Romans 4:16
