Proverbs 15:3

“The Sanctifying Doctrines of God's Omniscience, Omnipresence, and Grace”

³ The eyes of the LORD are in every place,
Keeping watch on the evil and the good.

Pastor teaches his family a selection from “the Proverb of the day.” In this verse of Holy Scripture, the Holy Spirit teaches us that the Lord’s omnipresence and omniscience not only warns us off from evil, but also directs us to hope in His grace to do good.

Proverbs 15 verse 3. These are God's words. The eyes of yahweh are in every place.

And maybe mommy is not around and then mommy's eyes are not around. And so she thinks she can get away with it. Do you know what the Bible says? Mommy's eyes aren't there, but someone else's eyes are God, yes. And you will not get away with it. God, who made you?

God, who made you so that you would know him. And honor him and worship him and love him and obey him. And then, because you don't, Who loves you and gave christ for you. And gave christ for you. So that you would know him And worship him and honor him and love him and obey him.

His holy eyes. Are in every place. Then we must always. We must always obey and serve and act and speak. His eyes are not just in the living room when you're in the living room and hear with us in the dining room. His eyes are in our hearts. And then our thoughts.

He can see all of those things. That will never do. To try to hide something from god. We often hide things from ourselves. In fact, we often need his word to show us what his eyes already, told him. To already told him and That's why his word is living inactive.

It's sharper than a two-ed sword. It reveals the thoughts and intentions of our hearts And one of the things that we don't often, Keep quoting and i'll I'll turn there and hebrews chapter 4. Because god already knows these things. And he is kind to let us know what is in our hearts.

Designer of the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And in verse 13, And there is no creature hidden from his sight but all things are naked and open. To the eyes. Of him to him, we must give account. And so it's a great mercy of god that he gives us his word so that we can know ourselves.

And a great mercy of god that he tells us in his word that in that his eyes are in every place. So we won't be the foolish. People who try to hide what we are from god. But as soon as we realize it, we know that he knows. And we come to the one who knows it, but gave christ for us anyway.

Gave Christ for us because of what he knows about us. And so we don't hide our sin and we don't play with our sin and we don't defend our sin. We turn from it unto God. Because, We've got a true sense of our sin. And an apprehension of the mercy of god in christ.

And what does he see? Well, he certainly sees evil but here's a miracle in the second half of verse 3. He also sees good. Good that he gave by grace. Good, that he gave. By union with christ. And the working of his spirit to apply christ to us. And now, there is life and love, and righteousness and obedience.

And the hearts of those who are his through faith and jesus christ. Isn't a wonderful thing, but the eyes of god that are in every place might see good. Doesn't that motivate you? To think good and desire. Good love, good. That the lord might be pleased with what we sees of christ.

When he looks at your own heart, your own mind. And especially, How we speak, how we act. As well. What a wonderful little verse the eyes of yahweh. Are in every place keeping watch. On the evil. And the good. Let's pray.

Well, thank you lord, for this wonderful reminder. Indeed. That is not as if we have heard something new. But we have heard newly. How much we need to remember it. And so, we come now asking that your spirit would write the truth of this verse on our hearts. And that we would be mindful of it.

We praise you. Oh god, who have been so merciful to sinners such as we are. We pray that you would produce much good in us. That your eyes would see when they look at us. That you would be pleased in christ would be glorified. And his name, we ask him.
