Ephesians 6:17b

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<sup>10</sup> Finally, get empowered in the Lord and in the might of His strength.

<sup>11</sup> Put on the full armor of God, so that you will have power<sup>1</sup> to stand against the strategies of the Devil; <sup>12</sup> because our grappling is not against blood and flesh, but *instead* against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic potentates over this darkness, against the spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenlies. <sup>13</sup> For this reason, take up the full armor of God, in order that you may have power<sup>2</sup> to stand against *them* in the

wicked day, and having accomplished all things, to stand!

<sup>14</sup> Stand, therefore: having belted your waist around with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, <sup>15</sup> and having shod your feet with preparation *provided* by the good news<sup>3</sup> of peace, <sup>16</sup> in all *situations* having taken up the shield of the faith, with which you will have power<sup>4</sup> to extinguish all the fiery arrows of the wicked one. <sup>17</sup> And the helmet of salvation accept, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;...
