- In a recent poll (3-29-23) from the *Wall Street Journal*, they found that "faith" as a top priority for Americans went from 62% in 1998 to 39%. Raising children went from being "very important," fell from 59% to 30%. The study identified only one value that has grown in importance over the last 25 years—the love of money, which has risen from 31% to 43%.
