Introduction

- 1. Do you want to live a life of true gratitude to God? How is this possible?
- 2. We find in this section a fierce loyalty to God's Word (vs. 106, 109, 111 & 112).

What This Means

- 1. Picture here is a traveler who makes a journey in the darkness who needs light.
- 2. What does the Word illuminate? What does it show us on the pathway?
- 3. What this means is that the Word of God is the only guide you can depend on.

What the Word Produces

- 1. The Word produces a life of righteousness and obedience to God's Word.
- 2. The Word brings resistance and grace to overcome that resistance.
- 3. The Word produces joy in our lives.

How We Respond

- 1. Psalmist responds by confessing that he will keep God's righteous judgments (vs. 106, 109, 110 & 112)
 - a. First, the Psalmist is saying that he will study, meditate, memorize and learn God's Word.
 - b. The Psalmist responds that he will follow God's Word. He will order his life by the Word.
- 2. Finally, we respond with worship (vs. 108).
