We Wrestle not Against Flesh and Blood (Part 2)

1 Peter 5:8-11 (Gospel Resistance)

- The Devil is: 1) Our adversary; 2) a subtle adversary; 3) an active adversary;
- 4) a **cruel** adversary; 5) a **powerful** adversary
- Our only defense: I) Gospel Light Exposes Satan Our Adversary (v.8)

II) The Gospel Command to Resist Our Adversary (v.9)

- We are commanded, with Gospel light, sobriety and alertness, to resist the devil.
- Threat within the church as angel of light & without by using persecuting tyrants.
- Encouragement: Rom. 16:20
- Jas 4:7 Christian is not helpless before the Devil (Eph. 6:10-18).
- Real danger is when Christian fails to resist enemy by failing to watch, pray and be armored with the spiritual amour of God.

1) We must resist Satan when he attacks us personally/individually

- We must **pray**, as Christ taught His disciples Matt 6:13;
- **Resist** and **flee** temptation 1 Peter 2:11; 1 Cor.6:18; 1 Cor. 10:14;
- If we do not flee and resist, we follow wisdom of our hearts Jas 4:14-18;
- We resist when we **stand firm in the faith**;
- We resist when we walk in the Light, with sober watchfulness GOSPEL;
- Eph.5:8b-16; Rom. 13:14
- Christian must not just defend, but also attack;
- Christian must have a firm and settled faith Isa. 50:7
- We must **give no opportunity to the devil** Eph. 4:27; Luke 22:3;
- God's grace is sufficient; our weakness should not be an excuse! 2 Cor. 12:9
- Js 4:7

2) We must resist Satan communally/collectively (body of Christ)

- a) We are not alone, but share a mutual bond; b) share in suffering;
- c) suffering is inherent in Christian faith; d) suffering of brotherhood spurs us on to hope...PROMISED LAND IS IN VIEW!
