The Community Outreach Team is sponsoring a food drive for the Woodstock Community Food Bank. We will be inviting the community to join us and will be sending messages to various places to get the word out. Food banks across the state have been stretched to the max to provide food for many folks in need during these times. We will be inviting all of you to "drive by" the church and drop off your donations and we hope you will share this information to your friends, neighbors and co-workers. It will be on social media so if you can share it, that will also help get the message out. The date is Saturday, May 30th from 9-2 pm which we will then deliver to the Food Bank at their direction. Precautions and social distancing will of course be in place to assure all who wish to help out. Here is what the Food Bank specifically has suggested:

Anything shelf stable, -here is the current list:

1)SOUP - all kinds, - low salt if possible;

2)canned protein- chicken, tuna, salmon, beans;

3)peanut butter, any nut butter, jam, jelly;

4)Any kind of cereal; hot cereals like oatmeal; Cheerios are a favorite, as are honey bunches of oats with almonds.

5) pasta sauces, and all kinds of pasta and egg noodles;

6) staples- sugar, tea, coffee; flour, baking mixes, baking powder, nuts, raisins ;

canned pie fillings; honey, molasses; small bottles of cooking oil, olive oil,

mayonnaise, small bottles of cider vinegar

7) healthy grains- quinoa, lentils, rice, brown rice, couscous, barley, etc.

8) anything else that is shelf stable that you folks think would be enjoyed, and useful.

The Food Bank also welcomes monetary donations which they use to purchase needed groceries and supplies to also be given away.

Social Distancing Practices for FCCW Worship Services

First, **trust in the Lord** and not our procedures. Then practice these protocols faithfully as a way of loving one another. Christ is in control AND He normally works through His people to accomplish what He is doing. (Jeremiah 9:23-24; Second Corinthians 1:8-11; Hebrews 2:9-18; 10:23-25)

Second, if you are sick, PLEASE STAY HOME. If you are not sure, stay home and make use of the live-stream. No one with an elevated temperature should come for any reason.

Third, we encourage those with health risks, co-mortality factors, and household contact with those who have such risk factors to STAY HOME and make use of the live-streaming for a little longer. As those without these issues return to more gatherings, even with social distancing protocols, there will be more virus transmission. So please wait and allow the rest of the population to build the necessary herd-immunity for you to be able to participate more safely later.

Fourth, *if and only if* you do <u>not</u> have higher risk of serious COVID complications and do <u>not</u> live with anyone who does, then please come participate in the worship services following these precautions:

- Please wear a facemask (no one will be permitted entrance without one).
- Please come in with your household members and sit together.
- Please maintain a distance of six (6) feet from anyone not in your household.
- Please keep an empty pew between your household and anyone else.
- Please refrain from shaking hands or any other physical contact with anyone not in your own household.
- Please thoroughly wash your hands before and after the worship service.
- Please only one person in the bathroom (or parent and child) at a time.

Fifth, please know we are doing the following to help protect you and our neighbors:

- Disinfecting all public surfaces, doorknobs, etc. before and after every service.
- Praying for the congregation and all our neighbors.
- Continuing to provide live-streaming for those unable to join physically yet.
- Removed hymnals and Bibles from the pews, providing Orders of Worship with printed hymns. You may want to bring your own Bible.
- Rope off every other pew to help maintain adequate distance between households.

Sixth, in order to minimize potentially lethal virus transmission

- We will use individual cups and wafers for communion on the first Sunday back.
- No passing offering plate—please place offering in box in the back.
- No-Contact Greeters will assist with social distancing protocols outside of entrances.
- Hand-sanitizer stations at entrances.

Acts 6: 8 – 15

Live Stream Morning Service:

The Case Against Stephen

1. Stephen Is Proclaiming that Jesus Is the Christ.

2. Christ's Opponent's Use the Same Playbook.

3. The Glory of Christ Shines Through His People.

Scripture records the resistance that Stephen (representing this new office of Deacons) encounters from those opposed to Christ. It seems crazy that anyone would oppose caring for widows, but they hate Christ and all for which He stands. Their strategy is predictable. They distort the truth and stir up dissension just like the Father of Lies always does. The way of Life is always opposed by the forces of death. At least for the moment. Stephen's radiance points us to the coming glory when we will be with our Savior King face-to-face. Let us so trust in the coming of that Day that we are willing to live to His glory today and every day until then.
