After a short break, he embarks on his third preaching mission, and soon arrives in Ephesus. What is the city clerk's advice?(19:35-41) _____ 	<p style="text-align: center;">INTRO, I CORINTHIANS</p> <p>Corinth was the most important city of Greece in Paul's day. It was the capital of Achaia, a province on the Peloponnesus, population over 700,000. A pagan city, full of the philosophy of the time, it was given especially to the worship of Aphrodite, goddess of love. Gross immorality characterized this worship and this city, to the point where a new word was coined: <i>Korinthiazomai</i> came to mean "to act like a Corinthian." 3:6,10 ; 4:15 ; Acts 18:1-7 tell of Paul's establishment of a church in this city. In AD 51-52, he actually taught the Word there for 18 months. Then, while in Ephesus, he hears a troubling report from Corinth, and sends this letter back as a response.</p> <p>The Corinthian letters deal with the issues of a church called out of a pagan society, as in the present day.
