The Source of Our Salvation - Chosen by the Father (1 Peter 1:1,2a)

- Last Sunday we looked at the man Peter, God molded him for this purpose
- His experiences & trials equipped him to shepherd Christ's flock in persecution
- His life was a living testimony of the power and the effectiveness of Gospel grace
- God uses fallen and broken people, did bring His truth to bear upon our lives

I. Chosen by the Father (1:1,2a)

- Two challenging problems regarding the doctrine of election stated
- a) Fallen man desperately wants to have some claim in having made a good choice
- b) Fallen man claims that divine election is unfair & therefore cannot be true
- Answer #1: as fallen creatures is our standard of righteousness higher than God's?
- Our problem: we think God is like us (Ps 50:17) His standard is not ours (Ps 97:2)
- 1) Peter identifies these believers in terms of their place in the earth
- Residents of Pontius, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia & Bithynia (modern Turkey)
- For the most part Gentiles with some Jews scattered through the Roman empire
- "Diaspora" the Church strangers exiled throughout the world, away from home
- 2) Peter identifies these believers in terms of their relation to their place in heaven
- According to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, who obey Jesus Christ, having being sprinkled with His blood.
- Peter comforts these persecuted believers telling them they were chosen by God
- Christians are set apart, chosen, God's choice possession (as Israel was Deut 7:6)
- 3) They are chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father
- <u>Foreknowledge is not foresight</u>- God never learned anything about man from looking into the future. Foreknew means fore loved
- To know someone is to love someone "Adam knew his wife..." Gen 4: 1
- For a husband to know his wife- the most intimate relationship on earth
- Jesus will say "I never knew" to those false professors (Matt 7:23)
- Rom 8: 29 God is not seeing events, God is foreknowing individuals
- Before time God chose those upon whom he would set His distinguishing love
