INTRODUCTION

In the fall of 1996, a 36-year-old preacher sat down behind a shed outside his parent's home with a gun in his hand. A multiplicity of thoughts ran through his head as he slowly put his finger on the trigger of the 9mm pistol that he had placed in his mouth. A war was raging in his mind. A war that was being fought for control of his life. A war that would eventually end in life or death. A war where one side fought to convince him that there is no hope. The other side fighting to help him believe in hope and forgiveness. The generals commanding these two armies in his mind are described in the following verses:

Gal 5:17 NLT

The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions.

1Pe 5:8 NLT

Stay alert! Watch out for **your great enemy, the devil**. He prowls around like a roaring lion, **looking for someone to devour.**

John 10:9 NLT

Yes, I am the gate. Those who come in through me. (COMMENT: THIS IS JESUS SPEAKING ABOUT HIMSELF) will be saved. They will come and go freely and will find good pastures.

John 10:10 NLT

The thief's purpose (COMMENT: Satan) is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose (COMMENT: Jesus) is to give them a rich and satisfying life.

God and Satan battle for control of our life. Satan wants to destroy our life while God wants to give us a life that is rich and satisfying. Whomever wins the battle for our mind & emotions will control our life.

Rom 6:12 NLT

Do not let sin control the way you live; do not give in to sinful desires.

Rom 6:13 NLT

Do not let any part of your body become an instrument of evil to serve sin. Instead, **give yourselves completely to God**, for you were dead, but now you have new life. So, use your whole body as an instrument **to do what is right** for the glory of God.

Rom 6:16 NLT

Don't you realize that you become the slave of whatever you choose to obey? You can be a slave to sin, which leads to death, or you can choose to obey God, which leads to righteous living.

This battle rages in all of our lives every day and we have two choices, God, or Satan. Whomever we choose to obey will determine the course of our life.
