The Beatitudes, Part 2 Matthew 5:1-10

Main Point:

As a disciple of Christ, you are truly blessed in Him; treasure the blessings of being a disciple above all else.

1. If you are a disciple of Christ, then you are truly blessed in Him.

2. As a disciple, you have a blessed future awaiting you at Christ's Second Coming.

3. You get to enjoy your future blessings now to some degree.

4. You are blessed only because Christ was cursed on your behalf.

5. Treasure the blessings of being a disciple above all else.

1 John 3:2 ² Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He [Jesus] is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. (NKJV)
